INTRODUCTION

This weekly plan has been designed specifically for a virtual mobility. We have tried to give an idea of the places you would have visited in presence through videos, lessons and activities thatcan't surely make justice to the real beauty and friendly spirit of Abruzzo but can make you feel closer to it. It is quite difficult to create an interactive spirit while sitting in the classroom with only the classmates from your country by your side and poor technical devices to work with, that is often the situation we live in our schools. Anyway, hoping to have future occasions to counterbalance this sad moment of pandemic, we wish you a very enjoyable and interesting week together.







We have decided to put some activities in the morning, to be shared all together at the same time, and leave you free to decide about some other activities, which can be performed soon after the first ones, in the morning, or later in the afternoon, in order to satisfy your different needs.

We have put the didactic activities referred to the main theme of this mobility (Biography) in the first three days. Each day two schools will introduce their work about a character whose biography has been read in the recent past. A kahoot quiz each day after the presentations will help the students to concentrate on their content.

A workshop called "Making Friends among Writers", to be done on the third day, after the last presentation, is aimed both at deepening the themes and contents which has been touched during the presentations and at putting in touch the students from two different countries.

As for the activities related to the cultural and historical aspects we have asked the help of two local museums that have organized two lessons followed by an interactive activity:

- On Thursday: a look at the traditional Abruzzese jewelry and a workshop about how to make a jewel;
- On Friday: a lesson on a very special archeological statue (the Warrior of Capestrano), found in our territory, followed by a guiz-competition between the classes.







Furthermore, we will try to make you closer to Italian food through the personal experience of our students who will prepare some Italian dishes and will film their work as a sort of tutorial for their friends abroad, in order to help them to replicate the same dishes in their home countries.

We have also selected some educational videos from the net that may help you to better feel the spirit of our region. Links are available for off line activities.

Each day we will create a Padlet wall that will be used during the week for notes and to store and share some digital products of our work. The large files will be stored in a virtual class (Google Classroom) whose link will be available for the coordinators only.

As for the daily programs:

Monday 19th: The Headmistress will welcome the delegations. After that, a student, a representative for each school, will briefly introduce his class/classmates and will tell something about what the situation is in his country/school, (emotional aspects and practical organization). Then there will be the presentations (Italy first and then Portugal), and after them the students can perform the kahoot quiz about what they have seen and listened to.

An ice breaking activity will follow (if there is time left): as some students are organized in classes and they cannot interact individually, a representative of each school will interact with the students of the other schools in order to share ideas about







similarities and differences between them. The result of these comparisons will be used to make a product (power point/photos/drawings, movie etc.) during the off line activity and put on padlet.

Tuesday 20th: Romania and then Greece will present their work. The kahoot quiz will follow.

After that, some Italian students will introduce and show some Italian recipes they have filmed beforehand. In the afternoon the students from the other Countries will try to cook the dish they prefer following the given recipe. (Written recipes will be available on padlet; the videos will be available on Google classroom whose link will be given to the project coordinators only).

Wednesday 21st: Spain and then Turkey will present their work. The Kahoot quiz about the presentations of the day will follow, then there will be the workshop "Making friends among writers": three groups of students – two countries for each group- will work together on the basis of the notes taken during presentations in order to find similarities between the protagonists of the studied biographies. Written instructions will be given. After that, during the off line activity, each school will create a product with the results of the comparison.

Thursday 22nd: A representative of each school will show the result of the off line activity related to the workshop "Making friends among writers".

Then there will be a lesson held by the staff of the museum "GentiD'Abruzzo" followed by a laboratory about how to make a traditional jewel. (Information about the necessary material for the making of the jewel will be provided beforehand.) This activity is available only for 8 students and a teacher for each country (under the rules of the museum).







Friday 23rd: The day will start with the lesson of the staff of "Villa Frigerj" museum about an important and ancient sculpture found in our territory. The lesson will end with a quiz/competition.

After that, a representation of students (max 2 for each country) will show the movies about the Italian food they have cooked.

A final ice breaking activity will follow, to help the students to express and share their feelings. The result of this activity will be recorded during the off line activity and put on padlet.

At the same time the coordinators will meet to discuss the whole week and future programs.
